

## St Bede's Catholic Primary School Sacriston Sports Premium 2023-2024

Our Sports Premium allowance for the academic year 2023-2024 is **£16,850**. The premium will be used to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles. The Department for Education's vision for the Primary PE and Sports Premium is that ALL pupils leaving primary school should be physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport. We endeavour to see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:

Opportunities were provided for daily exercise to support the 30 minutes per day target meaning that all children were able to access additional exercise opportunities. Children gained confidence and have had opportunities to lead class and whole school activities as part of PE lessons and also at break. After school clubs were attended well across both Key Stages. These sessions were fully inclusive and <b>79%</b> of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding attended regularly. Intra house competitions throughout the year helped to foster a sense of community and team building and</p>

						<p>allowed children an opportunity to compete against their peers.</p> <p>When asked about their experiences children and staff spoke positively about them and children appeared excited and enthusiastic. Achievements were celebrated via school social media and in celebration assemblies held in school. This has given children the desire to compete in future events and they look forward to the opportunities that they will have as they move into the next academic year.</p>

They have engaged in active sessions and also mindfulness and meditation to support emotional wellbeing for those children requiring additional support.</p>

Children enjoyed the opportunity to be able to play alongside their peers in a competitive setting.</p>

Staff have been enthusiastic about the quality of the resource and the structure it provides. Further CPD training to be accessed next academic year to provide support for new staff and refresh skills.</p>

They have supported younger pupils at lunchtimes to promote active play. Audit of the PE resources was carried out and new storage arranged to make equipment more accessible.</p>

Audit of PE resources to take place in the summer term to replace additional equipment ready for the autumn term.</p>
